Draw a line from the problem to the effect on animals


-pollution The changes in the weather can mean that cold places become hot and hot places become cold.

-climate change Land is cleared for food and the homes of animals and their habitat is ruined

-over hunting and fishing Poisonous chemicals from industry can ruin the places animal live

-farming Food for animals can become scarce or too many animals die ruining the food chain

-building Land is cleared for houses or shops and the animalis habitat is lost
