- Staple where you see this

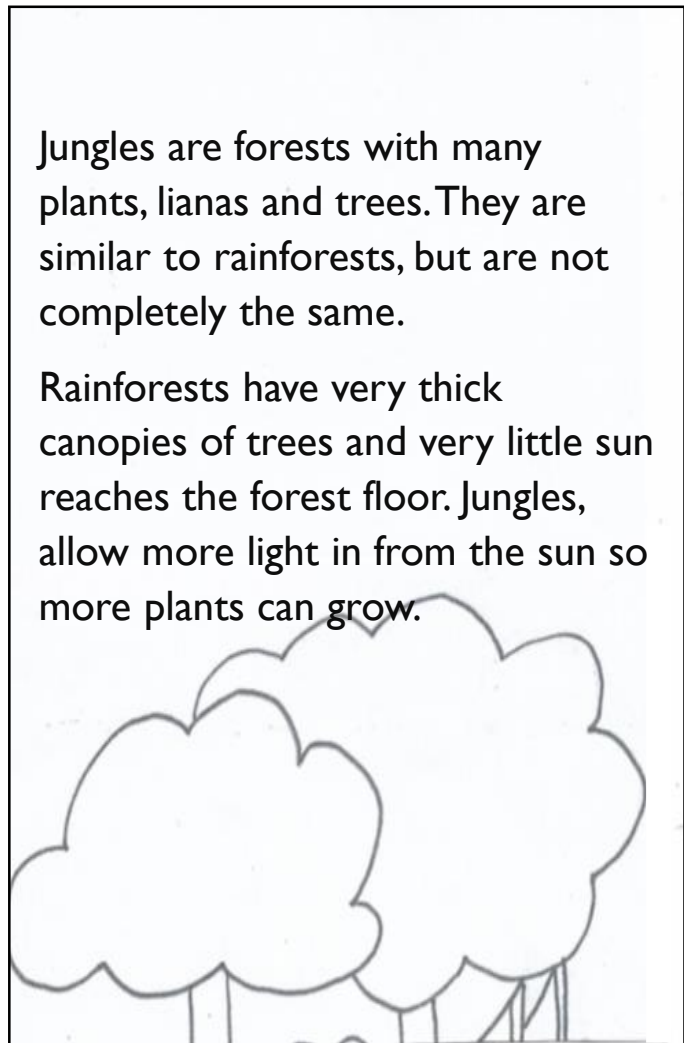
