



Plants absorb water and minerals from the SOIL through their ROOTS.

The nutrients go up the TRUNK to the LEAVES.

The leaves absorb carbon dioxide through very small holes on their surface.

Leaves are green because they contain chlorophyll.

The chlorophyll catches the energy of the sunlight to transform carbon dioxide into sugars.

During this process it breaks water and releases oxygen into the atmosphere. The sugars help the plant to grow.
