Away, you <u>starvelling</u>, you <u>elf-skin</u>, you <u>dried neat's-tongue</u>, you <u>stock-fish!</u>






Would thou wert <u>clean</u> enough to <u>spit</u> upon!








Would thou wouldst burst!









Poisonous <u>bunch-backed</u> toad!

I am <u>sick</u> when I do <u>look</u> on thee.







Out, <u>dunghill!</u>
